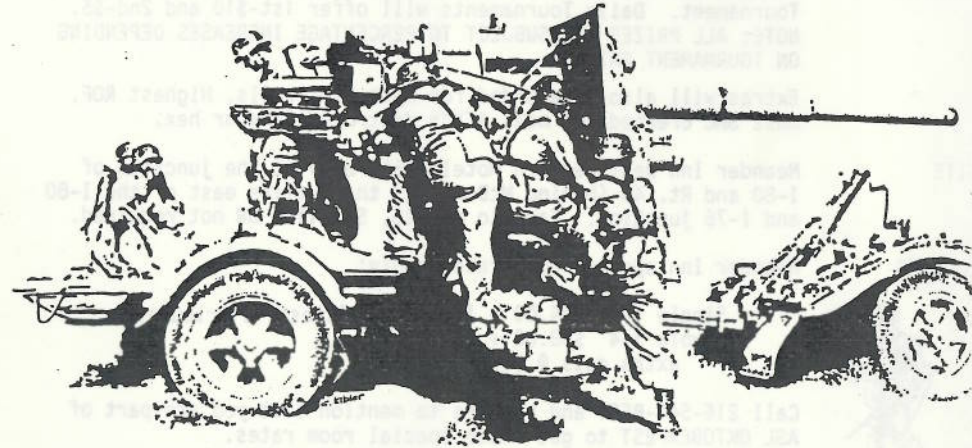

WHAT IS OKTOBERFEST?

An annual event promoting Avalon Hill's ADVANCED SQUAD LEADER system, where ASL fans can meet, compete and exchange ideas on the best game system going. Inexperienced players will enjoy the opportunity to learn while playing ASL, and experienced players will have a chance to hone their skills (as they grind the inexper....) during three days (60+ hours!) of round-robin competition.

Using basically the same format as last year, tournament play will begin at 0800 hours on Friday and run until 2400 hours on Sunday. Tournament play is optional and will consist of up to 8 rounds for the WEEKEND TOURNAMENT and 4 rounds for each of the DAILY TOURNAMENTS. Like last year there will be no set starting times for the rounds; as soon as you finish a round you may begin another with the next available opponent, or you may take a breather (however, you must finish your respective tournament within it's time limit). Scenarios will again be chosen mutually or randomly from a list of published and unpublished scenarios.

Special guests Bob McNamara and Charlie Kibler are expected to be on hand for comment on the ASL system, plus whatever surprises they decide to bring.

Two one hour seminars are also planned for those players interested and wishing to take a break from play. Friday's (1800 hours) will focus on SNIPER and anti SNIPER tactics, while Saturday's (1800 hours) will be concerned with the NIGHT RULES and tactics of limited visibility.

NOTE: Unless we are HUMAN WAVED again, OVERSTACKING should not occur. Both conference rooms are reserved, the upper one for nonsmokers and the lower one for everyone.
